Gentlemen:

Professional Service Industries, Inc. (PSI) is in receipt of the notice of violation dated 11/27/96, issued as a result of Mr. Eric Reber's inspection of activities conducted under the authorization of USNRC RAM License No. 37-28490-01, issued to PSI's Harrisburg facility. The following is submitted in response:

Upon review, it appears that the commitment to provide four days of on the job training "OJT" was included in supplemental information tied to PSI's 02/15/90 application for license. The commitment was not included in the 10/10/95 application for renewal submitted by PSI that was returned unreviewed as part of the USNRC initiated one-time extension of license expiration dates. That particular difference in the submitted radiation safety programs was not identified at the time of the return of the application for renewal. As the four days of OJT required by the license is not commensurate with universally accepted manufacturer's training or with draft regulatory guide DG-008, PSI will submit an amendment request under separate cover to update PSI's radiation safety training program for moisture/density gauge operators to USNRC Region I. Full compliance will be achieved upon issuance of an amendment to USNRC RAM License No. 37-28490-01 updating PSI's radiation safety training program for moisture/density gauge operators.
