It's true I'm not in your district -
The subject of my concern is one that
would affect all persons regardless what
district one lives in -

Nuclear Waste. I recall attending in-
formation meetings in the 1970's when Virginia
Power Corp promised that storage methods in
this country use casks - Nuclear Power
plants in other states use casks -
I don't know the 6 states - Perhaps your
law and Will check this out -

Correct me if I'm wrong, but I
recall the federal government at that
time promise to have a radioactive waste
repository far from the North Anna Power
Station operated by Virginia Power -

Over the years has there been any
dialogue in the General Assembly about
Nuclear Waste? We can be sure the
number of spent fuel rods have increased
at North Anna since the 1970's -

As I recall, it was in the early 80's that Congress passed a law (again correct me if I'm wrong) that a federal waste storage facility would be available to public utilities by 1998 —

Is there dialogue going on in the General Assembly to say this is going to take place? At this time storage of this waste is much too close for comfort —

Time is a factor !! Much waste must be made an and I want finding a storage area so radioactive materials can be hauled away from Lewis and other communities —

Many others along with myself are very concerned about this matter - I hope representatives on both sides of the aisle will come together on this matter —
