The purpose of this modification is to revise the number of documents estimated under Task 2 for processing. These documents will be processed and support provided in accordance with Labat-Anderson's proposal dated October 28, 1996. Accordingly, the following changes are made.

The last two sentences of the second paragraph of Task 2 on page 9 of the statement of work (SOW) are deleted entirely and replaced with the following:

" NRC requires that approximately 19,000 documents currently designated for processing all be available in the SUMMATION database for searching no later than 12 (twelve) weeks following NRC's acceptance of any revisions resulting from the demonstration of the pilot system. NRC expects access to partial database holdings as soon as the database has been installed, loaded and becomes stabilized in the NRC network environment."

All other terms and conditions of this agreement remain unchanged.
