SUBJECT: ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW SUPPORT - ANL

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We request that a revised proposal be obtained from Argonne National Laboratory (ANL) for future work in support of our ongoing effort related to the decommissioning of the Kerr-McGee Rare Earths Facility. The work will involve preparation of a supplemental environmental statement and providing expert testimony for the hearing.

The statement of work previously used for the ANL work (see September 29, 1982, attachment to SOEW 50-83-01) should be modified to reflect the new work. Paragraphs 2.0, 3.2, and 6.0 should be rewritten as shown in the enclosure.

In their proposal, ANL should provide a schedule for preparation of the environmental statement.

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2.0 Work Required

The performing organization shall furnish the necessary qualified personnel, facilities, materials and services to prepare a supplemental environmental statement related to decommissioning of the Kerr-McGee West Chicago Rare Earths Facility. This will include preparation of a draft supplemental environmental statement, the resolution of comments received on the draft environmental statement, preparation of the final supplemental environmental statement and the providing of expert testimony for any hearing.

3.2 Environmental Impact Statement

A preliminary draft of each environmental statement will be completed and submitted to NRC. Following review by the NMSS staff, each environmental statement will be completed for publication by ANL. The FES will include comments on the DES and appropriate responses to the comments. The draft and final environmental statements will be prepared as NUREG documents.

The following number of copies of the required reports shall be furnished by the performing organization to the Project Manager:

1. Preliminary Drafts - Six (6) copies
2. DES & FES - One (1) camera-ready copy
Six (6) copies

6.0 Period of Performance —

Performance under this work order shall commence on April 1, 1985 and shall continue through September 30, 1986.
