PROPOSED MODIFICATION TO STATEMENT OF WORK
FOR TRANSPORTATION/FIXED SITE VULNERABILITY APPRAISALS
(INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. NRC-02-76-311)

Article I - Period of Performance is to be modified by adding the following:

"The period of performance under this agreement is extended until December 31, 1985".

Article II - Scope of Work is to be modified by adding the following: "The approximate number of facilities to be evaluated shall be increased from fifty-nine (59) to seventy-nine (79). To assist in estimating travel costs, the twenty (20) sites to be evaluated during 1985 may be considered to be in the Eastern and Central U.S.

In addition, funds under this contract may be used to reimburse Army personnel for travel and per diem costs incurred pursuant to mutually agreed upon training in reactor technology and other areas in support of the evaluation program. To assist in estimating these costs, the training can be considered to be eight (8) one week courses at a location in the Central U.S."
