Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. C. C. Casey of this office on July 18, 1985 of activities at Scioto Memorial Hospital authorized by NRC Byproduct and to the discussion of our findings with you, Dr. George Johnson and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated June 21, 1982, regarding apparent items of noncompliance found during our April 21, 1982 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection of Licenses No 34-15938-01 and No. SNM-1788.

However, during this inspection of License No. 34-15938-02, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.

We will gladly discuss any questions you have concerning this inspection.
