Dear Mr. Brinkman:

We have recently received Byproduct Material License
No. 17-6751-1 and Amendment No. 1 to this license and note that item
No. 9 in each of these documents states:

"Authorized Use: To be used as components of
a device for measuring fluid density in the
laboratory."

Our application did not indicate nor is it intended that the instrument
be used in the laboratory. The gravitometer is intended for continuous
duty in a process plant and will utilize a slip stream of hydrocarbon
product as a sample. The instrument will be physically located in a
shelter not normally occupied for other purposes. We therefore request
that the subject license be amended to clarify this point.
