Gentlemen,

This letter is in response to a Notice of Violation from an Inspection by your office on July 16-17, 1996.

During a period between May 13 and June 29, 1996 our Firm performed Radiography at the Pensacola Naval Air Station on dates which were not included in our initial filing of Form 241 on March 1, 1996.

The reason for this violation was basically poor management on our part. We were to have completed this project in approximately 5 visits and we thought that we by far exceeded the the time frame on the Form 241 (March 1 through April 30) that we would need to complete the job. The NDE Manager filled out the time frame on the 241 so the Assistant Manager and the RSO had no reason to believe that additional filing would be required. Unfortunately, toward the end of April, the NDE Manager was required to begin long term projects on the West Coast, the East Coast and out of the country. Consequently, the project was extended by bits and pieces and the NDE Manager made the unintentional mistake of not remembering to re-file for the time frame of the additional visits.

The corrective steps taken and results acheived were a re-filing of Form 241 with an extension of dates listed and approval on 7/19/96.

The corrective steps that have been taken to prevent a further occurrence of this nature are:

1. The NDE Manager, the NDE Assistant Manager and the RSO will all be made aware of any future Form 241 filings and the dates listed.
2. Copies of approved Form 241 will be posted in appropriate locations to ensure the the dates listed are not exceeded without additional filing or waiver.

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




