We have reviewed the ANL proposal, as modified by their May 15, 1985 letter, for preparation of a supplemental EIS for the Kerr-McGee site in West Chicago and for continuing support effort related to the ongoing hearings. We find that the proposal is acceptable. Specifically we find that:

1. The technical work is consistent with NMSS program needs.


