SUBJECT: END OF FY 1982 BUSINESS

NRC is requested to have all remaining FY 1982 business concerning ANL and Ames Laboratory completed by September 10, 1982. Those NRC work orders (Form 173s) received by DOE/CH after September 10 that involve FY 1982 action will not be accepted due to insufficient time to take contractual action.

Enclosed is a listing of on-going NRC accounts at ANL and Ames Laboratory which will run out of funding on or shortly after October 1, 1982. The estimated amount of funding needed by Laboratories to continue work until mid-November is shown respectively on the enclosed listing for each account. Likewise, those on-going NRC accounts which are not included on the enclosed listing can be assumed to have sufficient funding to cover work until mid-November.

In order to avoid any program interruption or work stoppage, NRC is requested to provide sufficient funding for those FY 1982 NRC programs at ANL or Ames Laboratory that will continue into FY 1983 so as to cover costs until mid-November to accommodate the possibility of a "Continuing Resolution" condition for FY 1983. It should be noted that should a funding shortfall occur, the Laboratories will stop work and redirect personnel. DOE/CH can not guarantee the return of key personnel or the acceptance of continuing work when funding does become available.
