Pinal Minerals & Mining, Ltd. is in the final stages of completing construction on a 100-gpm Ion Exchange Plant.


The purpose of this plant is to remove uranium from leach liquors. As we discussed, it will be necessary for Pinal Minerals & Mining, Ltd. to obtain certain licenses from the Arizona Atomic Energy Commission.
