Pinal Mining and Minerals: Overdue on Submission of Renewal

Application or Request for Termination.

SUMMARY

Mr. Clary returned my two previous calls at 4:45 p.m. I informed Mr. Clary the USNRC was still not in receipt of either a renewal application or a termination request for SUA-1388 which were due on April 1, 1984 as prescribed in Amendment No. 1 to the license dated April 22, 1983. Mr. Clary indicated that it was an oversight and that all his records are still in storage. He expressed the opinion that he still had hopes of negotiating with another mining concern to take over the facility for the purpose of silver recovery. I indicated to Mr. Clary that he would need to properly decommission and received NRC approval on his license termination prior to releasing the facility to a non-licensee for use in other non-licensable minerals extractions in accordance to 10 CFR 40.46 and 40.51. I recommended that he submit a request for termination of his license immediately. I indicated that it was important to receive this request for termination by May 31, 1984, the established termination date of the license. Pinal had already exceeded the renewal filing requirements of 10 CFR 40.43b. I informed Mr. Clary that License Condition 14(B) advised that a request for termination should be supported by decommissioning plans and surety as prescribed in License


