SUBJECT: FEE FOR LICENSE SUA-1388 - PINAL MINERALS AND MINING, LTD.

The State of Arizona transferred control of licensing uranium mills and tailings back to the NRC in 1980. Pinal Minerals was licensed by the State for heap-leach activities and the license was transferred to the NRC in 1980. On November 16, 1981, License SUA-1388 was issued to replace the State license, and to authorize the same activities authorized by the State license. In a December 7, 1981 memorandum from the Division of Waste Management, we were informed that the issuance of License SUA-1388 was necessitated because of the State license transfer over which Pinal Minerals had no control.

Based on the foregoing, and because no application was filed by Pinal Minerals for an NRC license, no fee was required for the issuance of License SUA-1388.

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Source and Byproduct Material License No. SUA-1388 was issued November 16, 1981 to Pinal Minerals and Mining. The Pinal Facility was previously licensed by the Arizona Atomic Energy Commission (AAEC) which transferred the license to the NRC in 1980. SUA-1388 merely replaces the AAEC license and authorizes the same activities authorized by the old AAEC license. This licensing action was necessitated by the license transfer, over which Pinal had no control, and therefore was issued solely for the benefit of the Commission. The license is exempt from fees.
