Dear Mr. Speciale:

On December 27, 1996, we transmitted the results of the December 4, 1996, inspection of your compliance with the Order Suspending License dated August 5, 1996. In Section 5 of the enclosed inspection report (Report No. 030-19159-001), the steps that need to be taken in order for you to resume licensed activities were discussed.

To summarize the actions you must take, you must pay all debts that are owed to the NRC and submit a request for a new license. It is our policy that licensees who wish to resume operations following suspension of their license for non-payment of fees, must apply for a new license and pay the appropriate application fee. The Office of the Controller is responding to your December 20, 1996, letter requesting a waiver of the application fee and they will provide you updated information on the outstanding debts.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room (PDR).

5. Means of Re-Initiating Licensed Activities

The inspector and Ms. Cheryl Buracker of this office discussed with the RSO the means by which the licensee could restart licensed activities.

1. The licensee must first pay off all debts that are owed to the NRC,
2. The licensee must, in writing and under oath or affirmation, a request for relaxation of the Order to the Deputy Financial Officer/Controller, with a copy to the Regional Administrator, and
3. The licensee must submit to the USNRC Region I office a request for a new license stating that the request is administratively required by a ruling made by the NRC Office of the General Counsel (OGC).

6. Exit Interview

The purpose, scope and findings of the inspection were discussed with the individual denoted in Item 1 at the conclusion of the inspection.
