Teletherapy and Brachytherapy Course (H-313)

**Description:** The course provides a basic understanding of clinical radiation therapy procedures and dosimetry involving primarily cobalt-60 teletherapy (external irradiation) and various brachytherapy (implanted radionuclide) sources. Topics covered include facilities and equipment; safe handling of patients with implanted brachytherapy sources; inventories; and area radiation surveys. Responsibilities and authority of key personnel, Radiation Safety Committee, ALARA program, transport of radioactive materials, misadministrations, requirements for recordkeeping, quality assurance, teletherapy room design and shielding, teletherapy spot checks, calibrations, and source replacements are also discussed. Opportunities are provided for hands-on experience. Relevant portions of 10 CFR Part 35, "Medical Use of Byproduct Material" and NRC Regulatory Guide 10.8, "Guide for the Preparation of Applications for Medical Use Programs" are emphasized.

**Length:** 5 Days 40 Instructional Hours
