A message from the Citizens Awareness Network

Editors Note:

This is likely to be a very significant conference and the first ever in the State of Connecticut. The issues to be discussed are much more significant than the recent CY event with the nitrogen. This will discuss the fact that had a LOCA occurred, it was likely there would be no long term Emergency Core Cooling. There is no other safety system to back these systems up. If a loss of power occurred coincident with a LOCA (design basis event), the containment may have been breached at the same time. This could have resulted in the loss of the three principal barriers (fuel clad, primary system and the containment). This condition existed for the past 28 years.

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
