Subject: Hannon's Employee concerns Study

John:

Yesterday I discussed some of the details of the study with John Hannon. JH will be sending me a copy of my latest testimony for my review-no problem. Before my vacation, I informed John of a document that was seen by another NU employee. This document had the names of Feigenbaum and Kacich on it and discussed the future handling of whistleblowers at NU. According to my source the document discussed the fact that NU must no longer "coddle" whistleblower and must use the NU "Peer" program to "sweep" NU clean of future problems with whistleblowers.

I asked JH if he was able to obtain this document and his response was that he has made little effort to obtain this alleged document. If this document does exist, it is vital to his study and every effort must be made to obtain this document including a subpoena if necessary. This allegation can not be taken casually!

I believe I have provided sufficient information to the NRC to determine if this document exists and I expect the NRC to make every effort to obtain this document. I will certainly question the outcome of this study unless JH can demonstrate that he has made every effort to obtain this vital document.
