Dear Sir,

In reference to the notice of violation dated September 27, 1996, the following is our response to violations noted:

Item A-1

The Hazmat employee received the training required to transport portable gauge during the course certification conducted by Q/C Resources on January 13, 1996. Although the information requested was on file, Test-Con representative was not totally clear as to the nature of the paperwork requested by the inspector. See Attachment A1. As of 10-25-96 full compliance achieved

Item A-2

Hazmat Employee involved in the transportation of hazardous material actually received the necessary training during the users training course on January 13, 1996 and is on file. However, at the time of inspection the representative was again not clear as to the actual request. See Attachment A2. As of 10-25-96 full compliance achieved.


Item B

Leak test was performed in June 1996 however, the gauge was incorrectly identified by Test-Con on the Leak Test certificate during the wiping of sealed surface on 6/5/96. This mistake is corrected. Copies have been made and placed on File. See Attachment A3. In order to avoid any such mistake on further Leak Test Documents, these documents will be cross checked. As of 10-25-96, Full compliance has been achieved.

Item C

One badge was misplaced. Missing Badge was located and immediately sent in. Badges are turned in daily along with daily return of gauge for accountability purposes. To date all badges are accounted for. A time table has been prepared as a reminder to mail out Badges on time. As of 10-25-96 full compliance achieved.


