Gentlemen:

In reference to the above:

- (1) Corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved. Audits in keeping with the requirements of Item 6 (g) of the revised section of "Internal Inspection Systems or Other Management Controls" have been reinstituted and the radiographers that have been audited to date have shown satisfactory performance.
- (2) Corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations. A regular schedule has been established with target dates and completion dates that preclude the lapse in these audits and therefore the necessity for further notices of violation.
- (3) The date when full compliance will be achieved. All radiographers will have been audited in keeping with the requirements of the above by the end of the third calendar quarter of 1985. With twelve radiographers this will require more than one audit per week. After this schedule has been completed, each will be audited again in the fourth quarter of 1985 not more than three months after the first audit.


