Subject: Export License Application

Dear Mr. Hauber:

Please find enclosed a license application covering the proposed export by Westinghouse Electric Corporation of nuclear components to civilian nuclear power plants in Brazil. At the present time, Westinghouse has a contract for the supply of nuclear fuel components to Industrias Nucleares of Brazil for their use in the manufacture of fuel assemblies for the Angra 1 nuclear power plant.

Since Westinghouse anticipates future orders of NRC controlled equipment we are requesting authorization for all NRC equipment controlled under 10 CFR Part 110, Appendix A(5) through A(9), with a license expiration date of December 31, 2010. Additionally, we are requesting the license cover Appendix A(5) through A(9) items for all nuclear power plants in operation, under construction or to be constructed in Brazil. The dollar value of exports under this license could reach several million dollars.

Because of the proprietary nature of the information contained in this cover letter (i.e., dollar value), we hereby request that it be maintained in confidence.

Also, due to the near term shipment of this product (November 30, 1996), it would be appreciated if the NRC and other U.S. Government Agencies could expedite the issuance of this license.


