This refers to a telephone inquiry by Mr. Thompson of this office with yourself on July 17, 1985. This inquiry concerned activities authorized by license No. 18-19415-01, as they relate to the disposal of wastes to the sanitary sewer.

From this discussion, it is our understanding that you have not been disposing of byproduct material wastes to the sanitary sewer, but have been utilizing decay in storage as an authorized method of waste disposal.

If our understandings are incorrect, please inform us in writing.
