PURPOSE

1. To inform the Commission that on August 21, 1958, a Byproduct and Source Material License was issued to Isotopes Specialties Company, Inc., 170 West Providencia, Burbank, Calif., authorizing the disposal of radioactive waste in the Pacific Ocean off the coast of California.
2. Reference is made to AEC-R 35, 35/1 and 35/2 regarding the proposed issuance of this license and the Resolution by the State of California ~~regarding~~ concerning the disposal of radioactive waste in the Pacific Ocean off their shore.
3. We have determined that the license should be issued in view of the following facts:
 - a. We know of no scientific data which would indicate that our present criteria for ocean disposal of radioactive material should be changed.
 - b. No formal petitions to intervene or requests for a hearing in this matter were filed with the Commission.
 - c. Two other AEC licensees are currently authorized to dispose of radioactive material in the Pacific Ocean under our present criteria.
4. The Governor and Director, Department of Fish and Game, State of California, were notified of this action as indicated in Appendices "A" and "B".

PURPOSE

1. To inform the Commission that, on August 21st, 1958, a Byproduct and Source Material License was issued to Isotopes Specialties Company, Incorporated, 170 West Providencia, Burbank, California, authorizing the disposal of radioactive waste in the Pacific Ocean off the Coast of California.

DISCUSSION

2. Reference is made to Information Staff Papers AEC-R-35, AEC-R-35/1 and /2 which transmitted correspondence regarding the proposed issuance of this license and the resolution of the State of California regarding the disposal of radioactive waste in the Pacific Ocean off their shore.

3. In view of the facts (1) we know of no scientific data which would indicate that our present criteria for ocean disposal of radioactive material should be changed; (2) no formal petitions to intervene or requests for a hearing in this matter were filed with the Commission; and (3) two other AEC licensees are currently authorized to dispose of radioactive material in the Pacific Ocean under our present criteria, we have determined that the license should be issued.
