Recognizes elected or Presidential appointed federal officials who exemplify and promote excellence in government management and have demonstrated outstanding leadership in enhancing sound financial management legislation, regulations, practices, policies and systems (2 awards).

CRITERIA

- AGA membership not required
- For the Elmer Staats Award, individual must have been a Federal employee at the time the work to be recognized was performed.
- For the Andy Barr Award, individual must have been employed in the private sector at the time the work being recognized was performed.
- For the Distinguished Federal Leadership Award, individuals nominated must have served in an elected or appointed Federal position at the time the contributions being recognized were performed.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations should include the name and phone number of the individual or group making the nomination; the nominee's name, phone number, title, agency, time period and one or two paragraphs on achievements. Please send nominations by 10/18/96.
