

Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) is continuing work on the study of decommissioning alternatives. Upon completion of this phase of the study, SFC will submit a report to the NRC which will include the conceptual designs of the alternatives, as well as supplemental environmental information in support of the NRC Staff's development of an Environmental Impact Statement. Our original schedule was to complete the study and submit a report to the NRC by the end of October 1996. However, due to conflicts with other work priorities, it is necessary to extend the original schedule for submittal. Our current schedule is to submit a report on or before December 6, 1996.
