I, F. C. Rothen, being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:

1. I am currently the Vice President, Nuclear Work Services with Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO). I am filing this affidavit in support of NNECO's request that Attachment A to the response to the NRC Staff request for additional information, dated October 2, 1996, be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.790(a)(6).
