SUBJ: Amendment to Material License 26-00138-10 Amendment No. 14


Gentlemen:

As discussed in a telephone conversation on December 16, 1982, with Jim Meyers of your office, we would like to change the location of the J. L. Shepherd Associates Cesium-137 Mark I Irradiator from Room R-122 of our Research Building as indicated in paragraph D1 of our letter of September 8, 1982, to Room SW 208 in our main hospital building (drawing attached as Appendix I & II). All other statements in our letter will remain unchanged.

This change was brought about due to the fact that it has been decided to irradiate all blood given to IMMUNOSUPPRESSED patients, and moving the irradiator to the Laboratory Service Wing will make it more accessible to laboratory personnel during emergencies.

As the change in location of the irradiator is the last hurdle to getting the device we would appreciate receiving the amendment as soon as possible.
