Dear Mr. Holonich:

We are in receipt of a copy of your letter dated October 8, 1996, to Jon J. Indall, Esq., in connection with the above probate estate, and the last sentence of the third paragraph of trust letter is addressed herein. As you know from our office's conversations with you, we represent the Co-Executors in connection with the California Probate Estate.

Your office has received notice of the California Probate Court Hearing set for November 5, 1996, along with a copy of the Petition filed by the decedent's children. The Petition generally requests conveyance to the decedent's children of assets which they claim should not have been part of the probate estate. This is different than the children filing as creditors, claiming that the decedent owed money to them.

As you are aware, the children had originally claimed much more money was erroneously included in the Decedent's estate, and we were able to convince them that this was not the case. After our review, meetings and court conferences, as well as consultations with the Decedent's prior New York attorneys, the Co-Executors do believe that \$141,245.75 is due to the decedent's children under California Probate Code Section 9860, along with interest at 7% per annum after the decedent's death. It is my belief that the Court will approve and that no beneficiary or creditor will appear to further oppose this matter.


