Dear Mr. Mullauer:

I would like to thank you for all your assistance in processing the amendments to our radiation license formerly held in the name of DeYor CPF/MetPath, Inc.

A great many things were going on at year's end with very little chance to prepare for them. Your rapid response, particularly during the holiday season with reduced staff, is very much appreciated. Without your help, the group now operating as A T Labs, a unit of Assay Technology, may not have survived the changes taking place, depriving the public of the valuable role it plays in protecting the health of workers from occupational disease.

I am mindful of the conditions of the amendment. For the time being, Anthony G. Nasrallah, PhD will be retained as RSO. We will proceed in a more orderly fashion in the near future to document justification for change in RSO and file for proper amendment.

For your personal peace of mind, let me reassure you that no radioactive isotopes are in routine usage in this laboratory. The objective of the license is to enable the laboratory to receive samples from DOE sites which have been screened prior to shipment. These samples are not supposed to be above background levels. However, because shipping errors have occurred, we adopted procedures and training to segregate and screen all samples received from DOE facilities. We only work on samples at background levels. If a sample is above background, then it is isolated and returned once the proper shipping protocol for the sample has been determined.

Again, thank you for your valuable assistance.
