Dear Mr. Dillon:

We are in receipt of your letter requesting a change in the status of physicians at your facility who are authorized to use NRC-licensed materials. Your letter states that you wish to add Michael Cappelli, M.D. as an authorized user of licensed material. Pursuant to 10 CFR 35.13(b)(3) a license amendment is not required for a physician who is identified as an authorized user on an Agreement State license, provided that certain information required by 10 CFR 35.14 is submitted. You did not, however, provide us the information required in 10 CFR 35.14 to support your actions.

Please resubmit your letter and include the following specified information :

X A copy of the City of New York Radioactive Materials license which lists Michael Cappelli, M.D. as an authorized user.

Your original letter is being returned to you. Be advised that you are required to provide full notification to the NRC of physicians that you permit to use NRC-licensed material no later than 30 days after that authorization has been granted. We look forward to receipt of the information requested.
