Illinois Power Company Letter U-0671 dated September 30, 1983, incorporated the Licensing Review Group (LRG)-II Position Paper 9-RSB, Rev. 1 "Long Term Operability of Deep Draft Pumps" into the Clinton Power Station Unit 1 Operating License Application. The LRG-II position paper was subsequently discussed in meetings with the NRC Staff.

NRC Letter dated July 16, 1985, from Mr. B. J. Youngblood, Chief, Licensing Branch No. 1, to Mr. D. L. Holtzsch, Chairman, Licensing Review Group II, accepted the LRG-II position relative to Issue 9-RSB. This acceptance was based on the additional detail provided in the meeting questions and responses as described in the attachment to this July 16, 1985 letter.

With this letter, the LRG-II Position Paper 9-RSB, Rev. 1 and the questions with responses are considered incorporated into the Clinton Power Station Unit 1 Operating License Application.
