SUMMARY

I contacted GUILD at [REDACTED] and advised him that we wanted to arrange for an interview with Mr. VO. I also advised GUILD that Mr. VO had called me on 10-01-84 and requested that all contact with him be arranged through him (GUILD). GUILD explained that Mr. VO was working approximately 100 miles from his home and that he drove that distance each work day. GUILD explained that Mr. VO leaves for work very early in the morning and returns home late at night. GUILD also wanted to know the general approach that would be taken for the interview and I explained that we would be sending representatives from the Region and OI, and that we also intended to use a court reporter for the interview. GUILD asked if I would be coming and I advised him that my associate JEFF LANKFORD would be doing the interview. I also explained to GUILD that we wanted to do the interview as soon as possible and that we were thinking about next week. GUILD stated that he would have to contact Mr. VO to find out when a suitable arrangements could be made. There was a discussion that perhaps this could be done over the weekend and I stated that I anticipated a lengthy interview so that we could ensure that we covered all of his concerns. GUILD asked what interest OI had in the case and I advised him that I had not yet received any official word as to OI interest, but it would appear that perhaps they would be considering possible harassment and intimidation for reporting safety concerns. I reiterated that we did not have any official word as to specific/general interest in this matter by OI. GUILD advised that he would contact me and let me know when Mr. VO could do the interview. I provided both my home and work phone and requested GUILD contact me as soon as possible.
