Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter dated June 10, 1985, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the noncompliance identified in our letter dated June 24, 1985. During a telephone conversation between Ms. Judy Blith and Mr. W. P. Reichhold on August 2, 1985, it is our understanding that your corrective actions will include the following:


1. The Radiation Protection Officer will be required to give a four week notification to the Radiation Safety Committee, before termination of his duties as Radiation Protection Officer.
2. The Radiation Protection Officer will audit the program for compliance with N.R.C. requirements and report his findings each quarter to the Radiation Safety Committee.

If our understanding of the above is incorrect, please contact W. P. Reichhold at 312-790-5500.

With respect to Item 1, while your letter states that you have filed an application for an appropriate amendment to achieve corrective action for the item of noncompliance, it should be understood that no activity is in accord with NRC regulatory requirements unless and until it is specifically authorized in an NRC license. Steps should be taken to ensure that NRC-licensed materials are hereafter possessed and used only as authorized by your license. We will examine this matter during a future inspection.



