This letter will address the issues raised during the site visit held on May 20, 1985.

1. R.S.O.

The Radiation Safety Officer for St. Joseph Hospital is Donald R. Bryant, M. D. who will perform all duties of that position. He is assuming those responsibilities previously held by John R. Glover, Ph.D. Dr. Bryant previously has been the Radiation Safety Officer of St. Joseph Hospital from 1955 through December, 1978. A copy of his Curriculum Vitae is enclosed.

2. Cesium 137 Source

As the enclosed letter of May 20, 1985 indicates, St. Joseph Hospital will not use the 165 millicurie Cesium 137 calibration source until formal permission to do so is received from your office. Please amend the authorized user list of the Cesium 137 calibration source to read "Radiation Safety Officer".

Treatment Planning



5. John R. Glover, Ph.D.


