SUBJECT: UNITED EXAMINATIONS LICENSE 37-21270-01

This refers to your memorandum dated January 22, 1985 which requested that we check on the status of the subject licensee who failed to respond to inspection fee invoices.

On November 26, 1984, Mr. F. Costello of my staff spoke with the licensee President and was informed that he planned to return both radiography sources then in his possession to Tech/Ops, Incorporated in Burlington, Massachusetts and also planned to request termination of the license. Further, he stated that he would send verification of the disposal along with a request to terminate the license to NRC Region I. However, he failed to do so and subsequent attempts to contact the licensee by telephone revealed that the President has left the area and that the company is no longer in existence. The President had told Mr. Costello in November that he planned to move to Florida. A May 31, 1985 telephone conversation with Mr. J. Munro at Tech/Ops verified that the licensee had disposed of its two radiography sources on December 18, 1984.

Region I plans to retire the license when it expires in May, 1988. We will make periodic attempts to contact the President in the interim.
