The Commission has issued Amendment No. 20 to Facility Operating License No. R-77 for the State University of New York at Buffalo reactor. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your submittal dated March 8, 1985.

The amendment changes the name of the reactor facility, introduces a private management company into the organizational structure, and redistributes responsibilities related to radiological safety. On the bases of discussions between members of our respective staffs, and with your concurrence, we have included some additional clarifying changes in the revised Technical Specifications. The Technical Specifications are being reissued because of the many changes.

SUBJECT: LICENSE AMENDMENT REFLECTING CHANGES IN ORGANIZATION AND NAME

The Commission has issued Amendment No. 20 to Facility Operating License No. R-77 for the State University of New York at Buffalo reactor. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your submittal dated March 8, 1985.

The amendment changes the name of the reactor facility, introduces a private management company into the organizational structure, and redistributes responsibilities related to radiological safety. On the bases of discussions between members of our respective staffs, and with your concurrence, we have included some additional clarifying changes in the revised Technical Specifications. Two of these changes, in sections 6.1 and 6.1.1(2) make it explicitly clear that the University, as the licensee, retains overall responsibility for the safe operation of the Center. The Technical Specifications are being reissued because of the many changes.
