Reference (b) forwarded 283 questions requesting additional information on those five reports. Reference (b) requested a response to the questions within 60 days of receipt, adding that if this is not achievable, BGE should notify the Staff and propose a date for submittal of a response.



This date will allow us to properly assess, prepare and review the responses. For the remaining questions (approximately 15), we will require additional time to develop a response.
