Hello again,

Just spoke to Lenhart and he has agreed to forego waiving of fees. He also indicated that he does not expect to receive copies of the documents when he reviews the documents. This is in line with our preferred method of handling this type of review.

After he has completed his review and has flagged the records he wishes a copy of, you should copy the documents, prepare an index, and forward the documents to me for disbursement. This enables us to keep a handle on the fee aspect since he only verbally agreed to pay the search costs at this point.

If he becomes demanding and really wants copies immediately, you could make 2 copies of the records and give him the first 100 pages (which he will not be billed for anyway). Your complete set of records, with indexes, would then be divided into 2 categories (docs provided on 12/2 and docs not provided on 12/2) and forwarded to us for processing in this scenario. This enables us to retain control of the records for which payment is necessary.

Have I thoroughly confused you?????

Let me know if you need anything else -- bottom line --- It's ok for Mr. Lenhart to come visit on 12/2.

Jeannie,

Mr. Lenhart, of the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District, expects to review the NEORSO files AND the AMS files when he visits the region on 12/2. I sent him estimated fee workup using your search time for both subjects without any duplication and list of 8 criteria to be addressed before we could consider waving his fees. He did say he did not expect that the material would be copied the same day as his visit. Based on our current fee category assignment, he's entitled to 100 free pages of duplication -- anything over 100 pgs he would pay for.

As you are aware, Mr. Lenhart asked for a fee waiver in his letter of 11/2. I informed the requester this morning that we needed to settle the fee waiver request issue before he would be permitted to review documents. Please be sure to pass this info. along to Jack Grobe.

The requester is supposed to call me back (he didn't say when he would call back) but I hope to have everything ironed out by Mon., 11/28 -- we need to stay in close touch on this one.
