Dear Mr. Knudson:

As you know, both the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission have regulatory responsibility at the Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) site near Gore, Oklahoma. There is a site-specific memorandum of understanding to coordinate our activities at the site. The NRC and EPA also share a concern that, because of market forces on ConvergDyn, it is possible that SFC may not have sufficient funds to fully remediate the site. From NRC's perspective, EPA would have the ability to conduct some remediation and perhaps obtain funding from other sources under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA). NRC understands that EPA Region 6 has done a preliminary ranking of the SFC site, and that the site has a relatively low score. NRC also understands that if the site is not placed on the National Priority List, EPA's responsibility for the site would be transferred to the State of Oklahoma.

So NRC may better understand the EPA position regarding this site, please provide NRC with copies of the CERCLA ranking and any available supporting documentation. If you have any questions, please contact James C. Shepherd of my staff at (301) 415-6712.
