Technical Specification Changes to Address 10CFR50.72 and 10CFR50.73

As identified by Reference (1), ISAP Topic No. 1.38 concerns changes to the Millstone Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications which are required as a result of the promulgation of revised reporting requirements for nuclear power plants. Revisions to 10CFR50.72 and 10CFR50.73, which necessitated the Technical Specification changes, became effective on January 1, 1984. Licensees were requested to propose revisions to their Technical Specifications via Generic Letter 83-43, Reference (2).

In Reference (3), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) proposed revisions to the Millstone Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications to address 10CFR50.72 and 50.73. These proposed changes meet the guidance of Reference (2), however, they have not yet been issued by the staff.




