Arrangements with HMM Associates Inc. having been completed we would now like to terminate activities under license #20-14082-01.

Our final truck load of radioactive waste was shipped to Richland Washington on May 22, 1985. Radioactive waste drums picked up at the generator's site, using our truck, were transferred directly to a trailer which was stored at the rear of our facility. Periodically Tri State Motor Transportation removed the full trailer and replaced it with an empty one. Radioactive waste drums were never brought into our building. Our truck has been fully tested and found to be free of any detectible contamination. This same truck will now be used by HMM Associates Inc. to conduct their operations under license #20-20795-01.
