ORDER

It appears from a telephone call received yesterday from counsel for the Town of Southampton that that intervenor desires to participate in the briefing and argument of the pending appeals of Suffolk County and the State of New York from the Licensing Board's April 17, 1985 partial initial decision.¹ It is our further understanding that Southampton proposes to support those appeals.

In the circumstances, we believe it desirable that Southampton's brief be filed by the deadline for the filing of the briefs of the County and State as appellants. (This will enable each of the parties supporting the challenged portions of the April 17 partial initial decision to respond in full to the challenge in a single brief.) As matters now

stand, that deadline is September 30, 1985.² Should the deadline be further extended at the request of the County and State, Southampton will, of course, automatically have the benefit of that extension.
