ORDER

The oral argument of the appeal of Suffolk County and the State of New York from the Licensing Board's June 14, 1985 partial initial decision on emergency diesel generators<sup>1</sup> will be heard at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 26, 1985, in the NRC Public Hearing Room, Fifth Floor, East-West Towers Building, 4350 East-West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland. Each side will have 45 minutes for the presentation of argument.<sup>2</sup> The appellants may, if they so desire, reserve a portion of their time for rebuttal.


