Dear Mr. Madera:

On September 18, 1996, Integrated Environmental Management, Inc., technical consultants to Advanced Medical Systems, Inc. (AMS), forwarded to you copies of the procedures that Chem-Nuclear Systems, Inc. intends to follow in disposing of sealed sources of ^{60}Co canisters of bulk ^{60}Co . The purpose of this letter is to confirm that these procedures were submitted to the USNRC as additional information for Amendment 44 to the referenced license.

It is our understanding that the USNRC will review those procedures in light of our amendment application, obtain whatever additional information is needed from AMS or the vendor through verbal communications, and authorize AMS to dispose of these radioactive materials in a timely fashion. A license amendment fee in the amount of \$680 accompanied the July 2nd application. Therefore, no additional fees are enclosed.
