Dear Mr. Haddock:

This is a follow-up to our telephone conversation on September 30, 1996, in which I summarized the additional information we need in order to complete our review of AMS' and ChemNuclear's procedures in disposing of sealed cobalt-60 sources and bulk cobalt-60. I requested that AMS submit the following additional information:

1. A description of your procedure in handling the GE and blue casks once they are removed from the hot cell. It is reasonable to believe that upon exiting the hot cell these two casks will be contaminated. From our discussion, it is our understanding that AMS will treat these as contaminated and store them in the decon room, which is a restricted area. Please provide confirmation of this in writing.
2. Identify the ISP's that you will implement during the operation.
3. Inform us as to your plan to have a ChemNuclear representative present during the operation. If one will not be present, please provide justification. If one will be present, please describe at what point during the operation he/she will be there, and provide a description of his/her duties.
