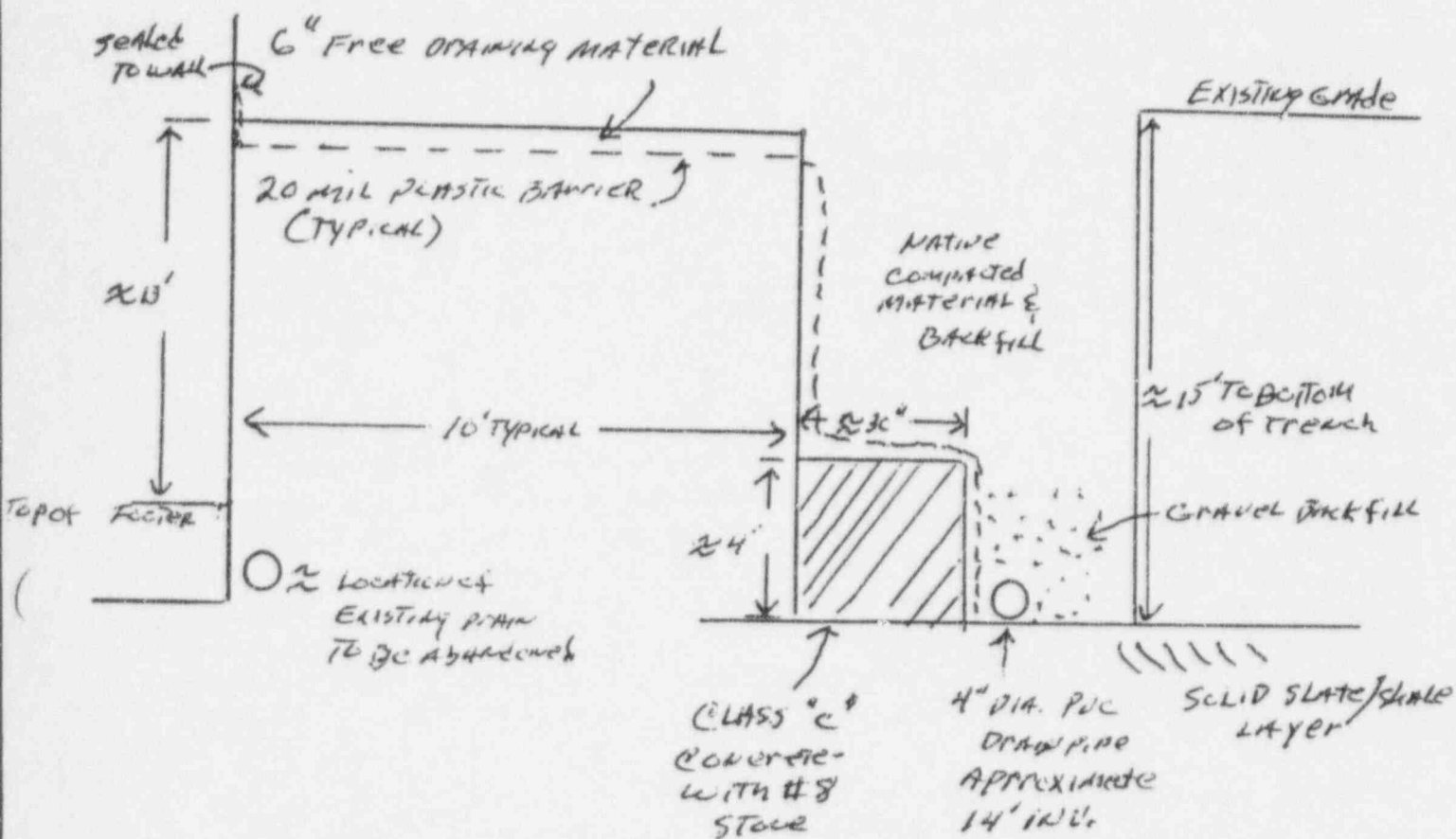

Dear Mr. Miller:

It has come to my attention that a new section of wall is being constructed outside the southwest corner of Advanced Medical Systems' facility at 1020 London Road. I contacted Mike Webber at the US NRC who explained that due excessive Cobalt-60 contamination in this area, and given the lack of sufficient shielding in this corner which abuts the source garden, Alan Duff determined that it was necessary to abandon this portion of the underdrain system entirely, and create a new barrier wall approximately fifteen feet away from the building.

I understand that the trench for this new wall has already been dug, and that concrete has already been poured. The building of any sort of wall is absolutely outside the scope of the work authorized by the City on June 30, 1995 for the replacement of the lateral and manhole. Construction of this type must be reviewed and permitted by the City of Cleveland's Division of Building and Housing.

I was surprised to learn of this new construction and distressed that the City received no notification, either formally through a written application, or informally by a phone call, to bring us up to date on this project and to notify us of AMS's decision to construct a new wall at this site.

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I checked with our plans examiner and the City's Chief Engineer, and have confirmed that no plans were ever submitted to the City's Division of Building and Housing detailing this work, providing information on the size of the wall, the materials being used, or how the new underdrain system will be connected. ASAP Technical Services and Longo Construction, your client's contractor and subcontractor, are well aware of the requirement for pulling permits before work of this nature is undertaken, and should have informed your client that plans must be submitted to the City prior to commencing work.

This project, which I understand is already underway, has not been reviewed or authorized by the City of Cleveland's Division of Building and Housing and is being done in violation of the City's Building Code. Your client must immediately prepare and submit a permit application form together with complete sets of plans to the City's Division of Building and Housing to avoid possible criminal or civil legal action pursuant to Sections 3103.11 and 3103.99 of the Cleveland Codified Ordinances.

Please contact me today so that this error can be settled as quickly and simply as possible. A building inspector will be on site this afternoon to document the work that has been done already. If necessary, I will obtain an administrative search warrant so that the inspector encounters no difficulty getting onto the property and reviewing the work to date.
