

SUBJ: Notification of Request for Termination of Material License at
VAMC, Butler, Pa.

1. This letter is notification that a request to terminate the material license at VAMC Butler, Pa., on June 30, 1985, or later will be submitted to you in the near future. In January 1985, a renewal request for the license was made to your agency. The request was acknowledged by your office and assigned the following numbers: docket number 030-10248; license number 37-16034-01; and control number 18523.
2. Preparation to discontinue Nuclear Medicine Service at VAMC Butler, Pa., by June 30, 1985, is underway. Services in Nuclear Medicine will be provided to our patients through Friday, June 21, 1985. Dr. Polizio, Chief, Nuclear Medicine Service, has begun disposal of radioactive materials and waste in anticipation of the closure on June 30, 1985. Complete decontamination and disposal will be finished during the week of June 24, and no later than June 30, 1985.
3. The comprehensive radiation survey report is being completed by Dr. Polizio and will be forwarded to you the week of June 24, 1985, when decontamination and disposal are complete. If you should require a site visit, it will be convenient if it can be scheduled during the week of June 24 when patient services have been halted and Dr. Polizio will still be available.
4. If there is any other information which you need, please contact Dr. Polizio at 412-287-4781, ext. 4243. In the meantime, I would appreciate your assistance in beginning procedures to terminate our material license. A copy of this letter is being forwarded to the Division of Fuel Cycle and Material Safety, USNRC, Washington, DC, 20555, and to the Director, Nuclear Medicine Service, VACO, Washington, DC 20420.
