Dear Mr. Wright:

On behalf of Bon Secours-Stuart Circle Hospital, we are writing to inform you about a transaction involving this facility. The address of the facility is 413-21 Stuart Circle, Richmond, Virginia 23220.

Effective September 1, 1996, Bon Secours-Stuart Circle Hospital, Incorporated, ("SCH") the owner and operator of the Hospital has a new sole member Bon Secours-Richmond Health System, Incorporated ("Bon Secours.") The members of Bon Secours are the Health Corporation of Virginia, Incorporated and Bon Secours-Richmond Health Corporation.. Previously, Bon Secours Richmond Health Corporation had been the sole member of SCH. This reorganization will not result in a change in the owner or operator of the Hospital or pharmacy nor in the services that the Hospital or pharmacy provides.

SCH will continue to exist as a not-for-profit corporation qualified to do business in Virginia. The transaction does not involve a transfer of SCH's assets nor is it structured as a merger.

Neither the corporate name of SCH nor the name of the hospital will change. The facilities will also stay the same in the permit. This transaction is not expected to change the operations of the facility.

Pursuant to the Regulations, Guidelines and License Requirements of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC"), notice is hereby provided about this anticipated addition of a member. We do not believe that a change in member of a hospital's owner or operation requires a transfer of the license pursuant to the NRC's regulations. However, in the event that you may decide that a license transfer is required, I have enclosed the information listed as required in Paragraph 4 of the "Guidelines for Material Licensing Cases Involving Change of Ownership".

Subsequent to this addition of a member, all of the rights, privileges, immunities, powers, franchises and authority and all assets and property of every description and every interest therein, of or belonging to SCH and related to the license will continue to be vested in SCH. SCH will retain all of its liabilities and obligations and will continue to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, commitments and representations made in connection with the current license and operation of regulated activities at SCH. SCH represents that all surveillance items and records are current and that any and all corrective actions required by NRC inspections are complete. All records related to the

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
license will remain at the facility. No changes in equipment, personnel, supplies, or procedures are expected to result from the addition of a member.

MATERIALS LICENSE

Amendment No. 15

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 39, 40 and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.


13. Sealed sources containing licensed material shall not be opened by the licensee.

15. The licensee shall maintain records of information important to safe and effective decommissioning at the licensee's facilities listed in Condition 10 pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.
16. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below, except for minor changes in the medical use radiation safety procedures as provided in 10 CFR 35.31. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
