Gentlemen:

This is in reference to your request dated April 12, 1985, for an amendment to your byproduct material license. In order for us to complete our review of your request, please supply the following:

It is not clear from your letter as to the training requirements for each person who will supervise the use of licensed material.

- a. Formal training should encompass a minimum of 24 hours duration covering the following topics:
  1. Fundamentals of Radiation Safety
  2. Radiation Detection Instrumentation to be Used
  3. Equipment to be Used
  4. The Requirements of Pertinent Federal Regulations (10 CFR 19, 20, 30, and 71 and DOT Title 49)
  5. The Licensee's Written Operating and Emergency (OE) Procedures
  6. The Licensee's Recordkeeping Procedures
  7. Case Histories and Potential Consequences of Accidents in Well-Logging Operations

Confirm that the proposed formal training courses will be of the above indicated duration and will be supplemented by your own training program addressing items a.2, a.3, a.5, and a.6 above. Indicate who will provide this supplementary training and describe his qualifications.

- b. The trainee should show evidence of satisfactory completion of this training by successfully passing an oral or written exam.

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- c. Formal on-the-job training should be, as a minimum, approximately 3 months duration working under the direct supervision of a user who has been specifically approved by the NRC, an Agreement State, or by a licensee in accordance with a specific license condition. Following the on-the-job training period, the trainer should be able to attest to the fact that the trainee has demonstrated a clear and concise understanding of the duties and responsibilities of the job, NRC Regulations, OE procedures, and the byproduct material license.

We will continue our review of your application upon receipt of this information. Please reply in duplicate and refer to Control No. 460598.

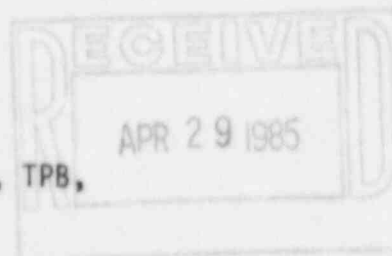
