Subject: SALEM ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE

JOE HAGAN, VP-NUCLEAR OPERATIONS; JEFF BENJAMIN, GENERAL MANAGER-QA/NSR; AND JOHN SUMMERS, GENERAL MANAGER-SALEM OPERATIONS CALLED 5/26/95. THEY INDICATED THAT THEY WERE NOT FULLY PREPARED FOR AN ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE ON JUNE 1 IN VIEW OF THE ADDITIONAL CORRECTIVE ACTION VIOLATIONS THAT WERE IDENTIFIED IN SALEM INSPECTION REPORT 95-07 THAT WE ADDED TO THE JUNE 1 ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE AGENDA. THEY REQUESTED THAT MORE TIME BE ALLOWED SO THAT THE CORRECTIVE ACTIONS VIOLATIONS FROM BOTH INSPECTION REPORTS (AS WELL AS THE LOOP SEAL VIOLATION), AND A RECENT SIMILAR CORRECTIVE ACTION VIOLATION RELATIVE TO RECURRING BREAKER PROBLEMS, BE CONSOLIDATED FOR DISCUSSION IN ONE MEETING (ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE). OTHERWISE, THEY BELIEVE THAT A SEPARATE EC WILL BE NECESSARY. THE PROPOSED DATE IS JUNE 23, 1995. SINCE SENIOR LICENSEE MANAGEMENT HAS REQUESTED RESCHEDULING AND APPEARS TO HAVE A REASONABLE ARGUMENT (AND WE ARE INTERESTED IN THE EFFICIENCY OF A CONSOLIDATED EC TO DISCUSS ALL ISSUES WITHOUT THE NEED TO EXPEND RESOURCES TO ACCOMMODATE SEPARATE EC; AND DESIRE THAT THE LICENSEE BE FULLY PREPARED), I RECOMMEND THAT WE ACCEPT THE DELAY.
