Subject: ENF. CONF., SALEM, RE: LOOF SEAL, ET AL

THE LICENSEE INDICATES THAT THEY CANNOT READILY SUPPORT AN ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE ON THIS MATTER ANY EARLIER THAN MAY 16, 1995, AND THAT TO DO SO WOULD SEVERELY IMPACT MANAGEMENT'S ABILITY TO MANAGE AND OVERSEE MORE IMMEDIATE ISSUES CONCERNING SALEM AND HOPE CREEK. SENIOR MANAGEMENT IS INVOLVED IN PLANNING IMPROVEMENT STRATEGIES FOR SALEM AND HOPE CREEK (AS RECOMMENDED BY THE RECENT ORGANIZATIONAL EFFECTIVENESS REVIEW AND PREPARING FOR A MEETING WITH THE NRC ON THIS MATTER IN MID- TO LATE APRIL. ADDITIONALLY, THE MOST RECENT UNPLANNED RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL RELEASE PROBLEM AT HOPE CREEK REQUIRES SENIOR MANAGEMENT INVOLVEMENT RELATIVE TO ASSESSING AND RECOVERING FROM THAT EVENT, AND PREPARING FOR A PUBLIC EXIT MEETING ON APRIL 21, 1995. THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF MAY ARE PLANNED TO SUPPORT THE NRC'S SPECIAL 40500 INSPECTION TEAM INITIATIVE (5 TO 6 NRC PERSONNEL ON SITE MAY 1 THROUGH MAY 12, 1995. SENIOR PSE&G MANAGERS ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE REGULATORY INFORMATION CONFERENCE THE WEEK OF MAY 15, 1995. MAY 16 OR 17 ARE CURRENTLY BEING CONSIDERED AS THE MOST LIKELY DATES FOR AN ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE.
